CKC is a licensed Before and After School Care program for kids in grades K to grades 7. The program works to support social and emotional development, connectedness, health and well-being through constructive activities, games, one-to-one support and group discussion. The program operates five days a week and on Pro-D days, giving parents a safe option for their children to learn, connect and thrive during out of school hours. Currently, we have four locations. Three locations in Richmond (Cook, Tait & Blundell elementary schools) and one in West Vancouver (Caulfeild elementary school).
